Code of Conduct for Players

A Player should:

Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.

Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game, even if his team is in the position where the desired result has already been achieved.

Set a positive example for others, young players and supporters.

Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and times-wasting.

Always have regard to the best interests of the game, including where publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any aspect of it, including others involved in the game.

Not use inappropriate language.

Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help his own team win.

Resist any influence which might, or might be seen to, bring into question his commitment to the team winning.

Know and abide by the Laws, rules and spirit of the game and the competition rules.

Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.

Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques.

Treat opponents with due respect always, irrespective of the result of the game.

Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and help injured opponents.

Accept the decision of the Match Official without protest.

Avoid words or actions which may mislead at Match Official.

Show due respect to the Match Officials always.

Abide by the instructions of their Coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict their spirit of this Code.

Show due respect, towards the Team Officials and the opposition.

Show due respect, to all supporters.

Fair Play and respect for all others in the game is fundamentally important.
